EXPLANATION DIGITAL CERTIFICATES

A digital certificate is a digital document used to identify and be identified when using the Internet.

InterCommIT certificates

InterCommIT provides 3 different types of certificates for business use, each with their own characteristics. Of course we can advise you what certificate to use based on your specific situation.

Personal certificate

This certificate is used to identify a person within the organization and the username is mentioned. This certificate is suitable to give an user permission to access a website and check the authorization levels.

Company certificate

This certificate is issued to a department, company site or joblevel and does not contain user information. It is used to identify a group of users and give them permission to access an application.

Server certificate

A server certificate is used to identify a webserver. Users can set up an encrypted connection with this server which is vital by exchanging sensitive information such as credit card details.

Certificates and Go-secure postal box

Go-secure uses digital company certificates. This way the identity of all commercial partners is guaranteed, both sender and receiver. Additionally InterCommIT can check the identity of users and ensure that only authorised users have access to the application.

Request a certificate

To apply for an InterCommIT certificate there are three steps:

- To supply the general company details and the details of the applicant (part A of the form)
- To submit the information to be included in the certificate (part B of the form)
- To provide a copy of a legal ID of the applicant (authorised to sign) and a copy of the registration with the Chamber of Commerce.

InterCommIT only provides a certificate when the information of the registration with the Chamber of Commerce and the applicant ID match.
